ELIGIBILITY

Open to all members of the NHCA, members of the following clubs will be accepted as one meeting members of the NHCA,-Vincent Owners Club , Vintage Motorcycle Club All riders and passengers must have a current ACU Hillclimb or road race licence

There will be an entry fee of £62.00 for one machine, £77.00 for sidecars and £22.00 for second and subsequent machines. These fees include premiums for personal accident and third party insurance. The club (NHCA) undertakes to insure each driver and passenger, indemnifying him against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic.

Entry fees will only be returned if the entry is declined or the meeting is cancelled. The Association reserves the right to refuse entry, to abandon, cancel or postpone the meeting and alter the programme No entry will be accepted after the closing date of events and awards

CHANGE OF MACHINE/DRIVER AND/OR PASSENGER

The secretary of the meeting must be informed of any changes of motorcycle/driver and or passenger at the latest before the start of Technical control on the morning of the meeting.

AWARDS

The meeting is a round of the National Hillclimb, Road legal and FE Championship. Points will be awarded for the NHCA Championship from the 2 competition runs as follows:-

1st place 6 points 2nd place 5 points 3rd place 4 points

4th place 3 points

5th place 2 points

6th place 1 points

There will be an extra 2 points awarded for breaking a class record in the competition runs.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

Solo's 100cc up to 250cc: 251-350cc: 351-500cc: 501-750cc: 751-1400cc

Sidecars 2 Track up to 1300cc with one driving wheel.

All other Sidecars Trikes and three-wheelers up to 1300cc.

Two competition runs will be made.

Where Championship runoff is not possible then outright Championship positions

taken from best of the competition runs.

REF Three track machines. Only single wheel drive and single wheel steering are eligible for Championship points

COURSE

The course is approximately 900 yards long including left and right hand bends. The surface is machine laid tarmac

TECHNICAL CONTROL

Competitors MUST present their machines and clothing to Technical Control before practice.

Membership cards and ACU licences will be inspected.

DISPUTES

Protests and appeals must be made in accordance with the National sporting code

PRACTICE

Competitors must start a minimum of two practice runs per machine, starting 8.30am Competitors must walk the course prior to practice. PLEASE NOTE It is compulsory to attend the riders meeting.

START

Competitors commence runs from a standing clutch start. All runs are electronically timed.

The finish line will be clearly marked. A braking area will be provided.

Any type of tyre is permissible. No tyre warmers will be allowed.

SAFFTY

Crash helmets must be worn at all times when riding any machine particularly when returning from finish to paddock. All competitors must return to paddocks in groups via Hill Climb Course only. No overtaking allowed. Return by other routes is strictly forbidden.

IDENTITY TAGS with name and date of birth must be worn

MARSHALS

Marshals will be required for a prompt start and safe running of this meeting

CAMPING

Free camping will be available in the paddock.

DIRECTIONS

The course is situated between Lichfield and Burton on Trent 1 1/4 miles off the A38 (Fradley Park Junction) Go past the auction centre and Go Kart track and look for the turning on the Left. The consumption of alcohol is strictly forbidden on the day of the meeting, both before and during the event. Competitors failing to comply with this ruling will be disgualified from the competition.

Dogs must be controlled at all times during the meeting.

Ensure the attached entry form is filled in and returned to the secretary of the meeting with the correct fee.

For each rider and passenger who is under 18 years of age a fully completed parental Agreement form (single event) is required. Parent / legal guardian must be present at signing on and available for the duration of the event.
